Legs materialize, not by adding legs, but by cutting away the redundant space in the middle, adding an unfamiliar expression to an otherwise familiar form. Scattered cushions, and deliberately slack upholstery emphasize the casual lounging mood ...evoking the ambience of nomadic tents of Morocco.

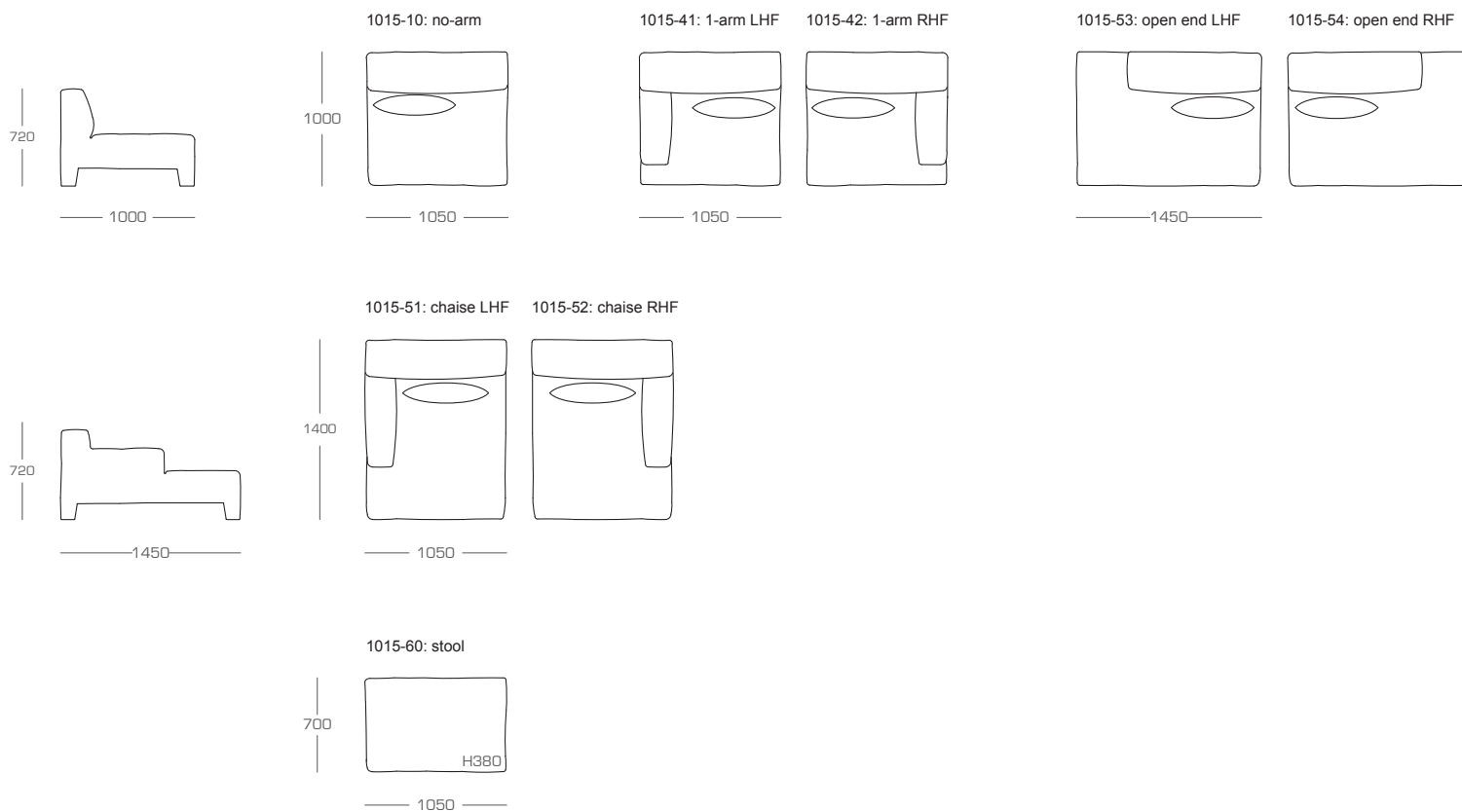
