Where we are at?

We strive to reduce our carbon footprint through responsible business practices and implementing manufacturing, packaging, transportation and inhouse initiatives wherever possible.

All cardboard packaging is currently separated and recycled from our warehouse.

All paper is currently recycled from our Perth and Sydney showrooms.

We are currently investigating recycling solutions for plastics, glass and textiles and aim to have this in place by 2023.

We aim for our showrooms and warehouse to be carbon neutral by 2024.

Our Perth showroom is also currently running off solar power.





stewardship

Our product stewardship program exists to manage the impact of our products throughout their lifecycle.

Our objective is to maximise the efficiency of our range by supplying high quality furniture therefore extending its life cycle. This in turn will minimise the the environmental impact of the product at disposal.

When a client no longer has a use for our furniture, Innerspace are happy to work with them to either:

- resell the product through a second hand dealer,
- arrange it to be donated to a charitable organisation
- breakdown the components to be recycled through a nominated recycler.

After all we believe that our products deserve to last a long time and that they can be repurposed for your next project wherever possible!

Supporting the Yarra Yarra Biodiversity Corridor

Innerspace is pleased to announce its partnership with Carbon Neutral in an effort to reduce our ecological footprint.

Located in the Northern Wheatbelt, the Plant-a-Tree program is Western Australia's most ambitious regeneration project, aimed at restoring the natural landscape and reuniting habitats by connecting small patches of remaining vegetation to create a 200km green corridor from inland to the coast.

Plant-a-Tree grows critical habitat for native wildlife on historically cleared land in a Global Biodiversity Hotspot.

For every tree purchased by Innerspace, Carbon Neutral plants an Australian native tree or shrub species in the Yarra Yarra Biodiversity Corridor. They plant on unproductive, degraded farmland with the aim of returning the land to its original condition and restoring the precious ecosystems within it.

To ensure the trees' long-term protection, a carbon covenant and carbon right are registered with the state government on the land title, safeguarding them for 100 years. This means the trees cannot be removed or compromised, even if the land is sold.
